Action Template for a cover letter to send to your local Council, MP, Energy Supplier etc.

Cut and paste the template letter to use as your own copy.

Instructions:

- Place your personal contact details at the top of the page on the right side.
- Add the receiver's address details on the left (list 'MP' after name.)
- Add the date on the right
- Start with 'Dear' or 'For the Attention of....'
- Print your name at the bottom of the page, followed by email address/phone number
- Include your signature (optional) at the bottom of the page
- copy all recipients via email

- Find your local Councillors https://www.gov.uk/find-your-local-councillors
- You can also print and post, recommend sending via recorded delivery
- Print the Radiation Research Trust letters to Secretary of State for Energy and Net Zero and include copies with your cover letter or include links to the letters within your email communication (links below)
- Follow-up within 14 to 28 days maximum if you receive no response.
- Always remain polite and professional

Dear

Please find enclosed copies of letters from the UK EM Radiation Research Trust raising concerns about the Energy Bill and Smart Meters.

The EM Radiation Research Trust letters were sent to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero on 18th September 2023 and 17th October 2023. I call on you to act on the information contained within both EM Radiation Research Trust letters and ask you to alert your colleagues to the risks associated with smart meters/wireless technology.

Evidence along with scientific peer-reviewed published research raises concern about smart meters as follows:

- Not suitable for those suffering with Electrosensitivity
- Fire hazards.
- Emit pulsed microwave radiation
- Collect personal data of private activities in the home in violation of Article 8 of the human rights act (Rights to Privacy)
- Can disrupt and disable medical devices such as pacemakers. (Outside scope of ICNIRP guidelines)
- The ICNIRP guidelines do not protect sensitive groups or long-term exposure.

Utility customers cannot lawfully be required to accept such hazards as a condition of receiving electric, gas, or water service.

The Equality Act 2010 must be considered. Discrimination complaints can be made if subjected to unlawful treatment (e.g., discrimination, harassment, or victimisation.) Consumers are protected under the discrimination act. https://www.gov.uk/discrimination-your-rights

Claims may arise for which the Government are responsible as authorising and administering the policies which were brought about.

This Notice of Liability and the enclosed information are presented with honourable and peaceful intentions and are expressly for your benefit to provide you with due process, due diligence, and an opportunity to remedy this most serious matter.
